Acts 2:23, 24; Preach the Gospel - Death, Burial, and Resurrection

Acts 2:38; What to do to be saved - repent and be Baptized for forgiveness of sins

Acts 2:41 - They were baptized

Acts 2:47 - Adding to the church day by day
